

## TVHRC Meeting Minutes 08-05-15

Members present were: Willie Alderson, Jack Smith, Ron Borton, Blaine Hyde, Eric Van Staveren, Dina Perugini, Allyn Foster and Laura Foster, Chelsea Jensen and Terry Sanders at K-2 Construction in Boise.

Blaine gave a financial report. The McCall Hunt Test made approximately \$5400 after the scratch fees are paid and we have made about \$1300 total this year after some needed equipment purchases. We still have a few small bills that will be coming in.

### Double Header:

Willie ask everyone for ideas that could make next year's Double Header run smoother. Suggestions were:

- Have a dedicated hostess
- Outsource the tailgate party. Jack Smith has a contact and will check with them.
- Figure a way to get more club members involved.
- We need more equipment. Possibly talk to IRC and discuss the possibility of sharing equipment for our events. One of the gas guns does not work and needs to be sent back soon if necessary for warrantee work.
- Possibility of having the double header earlier in the summer. This may be hard to do because of various conflicts with other tests.

Willie has two Judges committed: Tom Quarles and Dave Alexander.

The Banquet will be approximately the same date, the 30<sup>th</sup> of January.

The following people will be in charge of getting volunteers for their various duties:

- Blaine will check on hall availability.
- Blaine will take care of collecting dues, fees and selling raffle tickets etc. at the door.
- Ron will be in charge of set up – tables, chairs etc.
- Dina will be in charge of food and kitchen setup.
- Jack will be in charge of cleaning up the hall afterwards.
- Eric will be in charge of cleaning up the kitchen.
- Willie will be in charge of the raffle.

Willie suggested that we think about the possibility of changing our bylaws to something similar the IRC's so that we elect our board members on a staggered basis. The members would be elected to a 4 year term and 2 new ones would be voted on each year. The old board member could still be on the ballot if they wished. Pros and cons were discussed and it was decided we would think about it and talk at the next meeting. Blaine will get a copy of the pertinent IRC bylaws.

We will also discuss further at the next meeting having an advanced handler seminar. Either bring someone in or do it in house. It may work to have something prior to our regularly scheduled training days, especially for the new folks.

The club (Blaine) will order 50 rule books from AKC, making sure they are the latest edition. These books will be provided to club members. We will discuss at the next meeting exactly how we want to distribute them.
