

TVHRC Meeting Minutes: 6/8/17

Meeting called to order by Willie Alderson. Dina motioned to approve last meeting minutes and skip reading. Larry seconded.

- McCall Hunt Test
 - Opening entry date is posted per AKC rules for a limited entry stake which is June 21
 - Committee
 - Grant Settle, Larry Hill, Jan Holshevnikoff, Terri Sanders, Lisa Anderson, and Ron Borton
 - Workers
 - 8, 12, 10 helpers Fri, Sat, & Sun. More could be good to rotate kids out of the sun
 - Judges Gifts need to be ordered. Ideas include hoodies, whistles, gift cards, etc.
 - Food
 - Thursday night everyone bring something to share for potluck
 - Friday night pizza at campground
 - Saturday night could do Albertsons again
 - Water – works to freeze ahead. Kim will ask Albertsons in McCall if they will freeze a case so we do not need to haul or freeze as much water ahead of time. The club's current stock of water bottles is old and may not handle being frozen again.
 - Club could buy the pro's lunches as an added incentive for bringing large entries to our test. This was done at the recent SLC test and was greatly appreciated.
 - Committee can designate areas for each stake that judges can use to ensure each stake gets good grounds
 - Larry got two guns to sell at the McCall test
 - Inventory of the trailer needs to be done before the McCall test. Next Wednesday will be done at Larry's at 6 bring your own drinks, dinner will be burgers.
- Training day(s) before next hunt test
 - July 8 was decided for a training day. This will provide another training opportunity for members and get fresh birds for the McCall test.
- TVHRC Gear Order
 - Willie will order the min. number of hoodies and shirts to get the cost down.
- HRC
 - HRC will not allow another club to sponsor a test – invalidates a test trial option discussed at last meeting
 - Start-up is estimated at \$500 and each club officer must be a member of HRC estimated to be \$35 a year per person
 - Club members could supply wingers for the test
 - To break even on a test 35 entries are generally needed between all stakes

- Judges often judge one day and run their dogs the other day as an added incentive
- Club should decide if we are a joint AKC and HRC club or if HRC should be a separate club. Willie and Terri will work on a survey to send the club members to gauge interest in HRC
