Meeting called to order by Willie Alderson

Dina motioned to skip the reading of last meeting minutes. Eric seconded.

Open Issues:

Financials – April hunt test the club broke even but we made money on the July tests.

Annual Banquet – The last two weekends in January were already reserved at American Legion Hall. TVHRC banquet is penciled in for February 3. Larry motioned to keep a firm date for 2/3/18, Ron seconded. A-F Main, G-L Desserts, M-Z Side Salad. Discussion around potential raffle items – youth shot gun, yeti cooler, NW Game Birds gift certificate, next dog logo, etc.

Nominating committee update (Jan/Dina) – Ron and Chelsea's board position are up for election. Also Willie will be taking a break as club president.

Spring Hunt test – Now currently scheduled for May 18, 19 & 20 with possible grounds in Notus, OH/Q on Friday and double senior/junior with single master. This date is a conflict with the Master Amateur, but the weekend before is a conflict with Mother's Day. Another alternative might be the first weekend in June 1-3 but this interferes with the Montana Master Amateur in 2019. Larry suggested a double master instead of the OH/Q due to the desire for individuals to qualify for the Master Amateur in Montana 2019. Eric suggested keeping it a smaller event and sticking with our April date. Upon further discussion it was decided to stick with May 18, 19 & 20 due to the predicted limited number of individuals going to Missouri that weekend for the Maser Amateur.

Training Days – Month of February/March for new members and young dogs. Possibly due smaller events at Eagle Island leading up to a mock hunt test for the bigger training days. Eric, Chris, Larry, and Willie will establish a committee for training days.

HRC Update – Questionnaire will be ready soon to send to members.

New Business:

Dave Snider has secured some hunts to be auctioned off at the banquet or hunt tests, he has also secured a photo safari in Africa details to come and he has access to bird boys from a youth group for hunt tests and possibly training days.
